Sessions address evaluation and management of common acute and chronic conditions encountered in practice, with updates in infectious disease, cardiovascular and endocrine care, emergency and perioperative medicine, cancer screening and treatment considerations, dermatology, wound care, substance use disorder treatment, ophthalmologic emergencies, and post-critical care recovery.

OBJECTIVES: After participating in this activity, the provider should be more confident in their ability to:

1. Apply evidence-based approaches for common acute and chronic conditions across APP practice settings.
2. Incorporate current guidance for IV vs. oral antibiotics and antimicrobial stewardship.
3. Recognize, assess, and initiate evidence-based care for alcohol withdrawal and alcohol use disorder.
4. Use current best practices in acute pain, airway, emergency, and perioperative care.
5. Integrate current updates in cardiovascular, endocrine, pulmonary, and allergy-related care.
6. Apply specialty screening and treatment updates relevant to APP practice, including anal cancer screening, diabetic limb salvage, breast health, urinary symptoms, gender affirmation, and ophthalmologic emergencies.
7. Recognize common dermatologic infection presentations, incorporate caregiver trauma & provider wellness, and access-related barriers into care planning.
