Certificate Verifying Completion of Endotracheal Intubation Curriculum on OhioHealth University		
Trainee has practiced skill using simulation		
ASSESSES PATIENT		
Washes hands upon entering room		
Reviews Past Medical History; Examines for spine injury, facial trauma, neck surgery, mandible size, oral anatomy/hardware		
OBTAINS EQUIPMENT		
Mask with eye shield, gloves, suction device (Yankauer), laryngoscope, ET tube, Bag-Valve-Mask, CO ₂ detection device		
EDUCATES PATIENT/FAMILY		
Obtains consent (Discusses risks, benefits of procedure). Must include oral/airway injury, infection.		
Time Out performed. Must identify patient and procedure.		
PREPARES PATIENT		
Positions patient appropriately, Patient in "sniffing" position at appropriate height for proceduralist		
ET tube cuff checked, stylet inserted		
Laryngoscope functioning, suction functioning		
Applies pulse ox or End Tidal CO ₂ , pre-oxygenates patient as appropriate		
Can discuss rescue airway protocol		
PERFORMS PROCEDURE		
Laryngoscope held in left hand, mouth opened with right hand		
Laryngoscope positioned appropriately in oropharynx, visualization of the vocal cords achieved		
With ET tube held in right hand, visualizes ET tube passing through cords		
Tube held in place while stylet removed; laryngoscope removed; ET tube cuff inflated		
Confirms position with CO ₂ detection, and auscultation of bilateral lung fields. Both while providing Bag-Valve-Mask ventilation		
Washes hands; ordered chest X-ray; orders ventilator settings; documents note		
Totals Count	12/15 required to pass	/15
Percentage	Requires 80% to pass, must have all "critical actions"
