Trainee has practiced skill using simulation			
ASSESSES PATIENT			
Washes hands upon entering room			
Reviews Past Medical History; Reviews Labs; Examines for cellulitis, edema, hematoma, previous attemts			
OBTAINS EQUIPMENT			
Central Line Kit			
Ultrasound; Probe cover; Saline flushes; Needleless caps; Sterile Dressing			
EDUCATES PATIENT/FAMILY			
Obtains consent (Discusses risks, benefits of procedure). Must include bleeding, infection, pneumothorax, arterial injury.			
Time Out performed. Must identify patient and site.			
PREPARES PATIENT			
Positions patient appropriately; As appropriate: Trendelenberg, rotation of head. Confirms landmarks with ultrasound			
PERFORMS PROCEDURE			
Ensures all present with cap and mask. Opens kit with sterile technique. Dons cap and mask, sterile gloves and gown. (Must do all 3)			
Chlorhexidine to prepare site; Drapes patient "head-to-toe" (Must do both)			
Prepares kit and catheter; Places sterile cover on ultrasound probe			
Anesthetizes skin with wheal of lidocaine			
Confirms insertion site with ultrasound and positions needle relative to ultrasound probe			
Inserts needle 45°-75° to the skin, with ultrasound guidance			
Appropriately visualizes needle tip until vein cannulated			
Once in vein stabilizes needle, assesses for venous blood return; Advances wire through needle			
Once wire in position, removes needle while maintaining control of wire			
Confirms wire in vein with ultrasound			
Skin knick using scalpel along wire			
Threads dilator over wire, maintains control of wire throughout, and removes dilator			
Threads catheter over wire, maintains control of wire; Once wire exposed from brown port wire and catheter advanced as unit			
Aspirates blood and flushes all 3 ports, using sterile technique			
Sutures catheter in place			
Applies sterile dressing, or requests staff to apply; Disposes of supplies appropriately			
Washes hands; ordered chest X-ray; documents note			
Totals Count 19/23 required to pass		/23	
Percentage Requires 80% to pass, must have all "critical actions"
