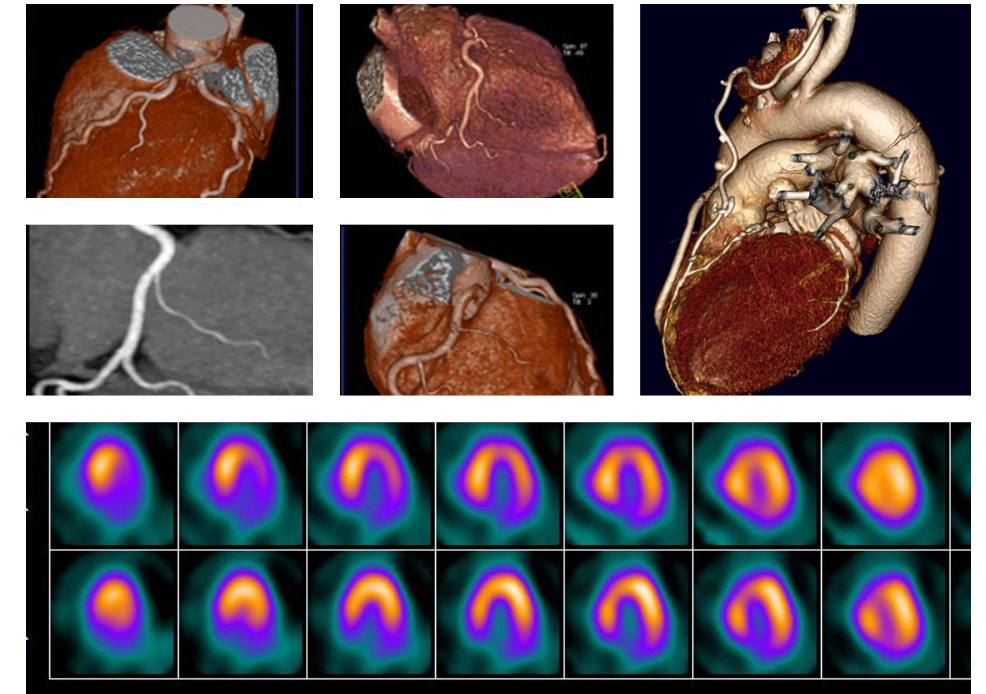

The 19th Annual OhioHealth Cardiac Imaging Symposium

Overview

This symposium is designed as a clinical update in the field of cardiac imaging. The intended audience includes cardiologists, CT technologist, cardiac nurses and nuclear medicine technologist. A computerized audience response system will be utilized to allow all attendees to participate and assess their interpretative skills anonymously.

Objectives

Following attendance, the symposium participant should be able to:

- + Recognize the signs and symptoms of systemic amyloidosis and the role of pyrophosphate imaging in the diagnosis of cardiac amyloidosis
- + Develop a greater understanding of the roles of myocardial perfusion imaging and cardiac CT in the diagnosis of cardiac sarcoidosis and other cardiomyopathies.
- + Develop the role of PET myocardial blood flow for recognition of coronary microvascular disease.
- + Compare the current status of functional testing with CT, including CT perfusion and CT-FFR.
- + Incorporate the results of SPECT MPI, PET MPI, and coronary CTA into patient management decisions.
