She is a Health Services Researcher with emphasis on Access to Care, Disparities, Violence Prevention, and Cost Effectiveness Analysis, and is the Program Director for the hospital-based violence intervention program At-Risk Intervention and Mentoring at University Hospital in Aurora, CO.

In addition to serving on the Editorial Board for *Journal of Surgical Research* and serving as a reviewer for several major surgical journals such as *Journal of Trauma and Acute Care Surgery*, she serves as a reviewer for multiple non-surgical journals, including Child Abuse and Neglect, *Journal of Behavioral Medicine*, *Violence Against Women*, *Journal of Investigative Psychology and Offender Profiling* and *Journal of Forensic Psychiatry and Psychology*.

Dr. Velopulos splits her time clinically as a Trauma/Acute Care Surgeon and Surgical Intensivist, and, administratively, as a Health Services Researcher mentoring medical students and residents, with multiple resulting publications in violence intervention, including Intimate Partner Violence. Her other job includes being a wife and mother to three children, four cats, and a dog.
