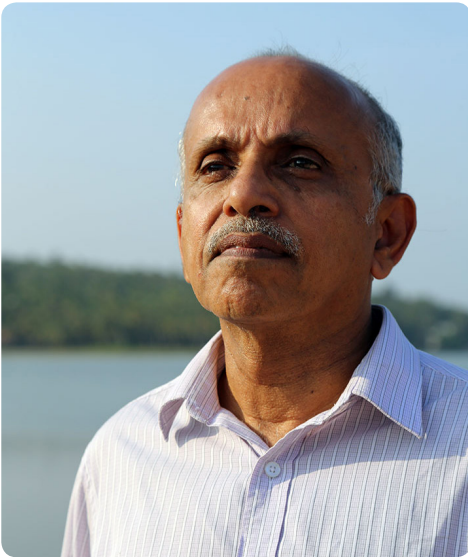


# Nobel Peace Prize Nominee to Speak at OhioHealth

**DR. M. R. RAJAGOPAL, THE FATHER OF PALLIATIVE CARE IN INDIA**

Dr. M.R. Rajagopal, or Dr. Raj as he's known, is an anesthetist who became the leading advocate for pain management and palliative care in India. Now, he is a nominee for the 2018 Nobel Peace Prize.
