This two-day conference covers current evidence-based practice in the care of specific trauma mechanisms of injury (MOI) that are most commonly seen at OhioHealth's three American College of Surgeons-accredited trauma centers. These MOI include falls, motor vehicle crashes and assaults for both OhioHealth Grant Medical Center and OhioHealth Riverside Methodist Hospital, and falls, motor vehicle crashes and motorcycle crashes for OhioHealth Mansfield Hospital. We will also highlight innovative technology for the evidence-based care of the trauma patient.

1. List postdischarge rehab interventions for the care of patients with traumatic hand injuries.
2. Describe challenges to prehospital care in the rural setting.

### **Samuel R. Browd, MD, PhD, FACS**

Dr. Browd is a professor of Neurological Surgery at the University of Washington, adjunct professor of Bioengineering and affiliate faculty of the Foster School of Business, and an attending neurosurgeon at Seattle Children's Hospital. He is also the director of The Sports Institute at UW Medicine and medical director of the Seattle Children's Sports Concussion program.

Dr. Browd serves as Seattle Children's director of Hydrocephalus and surgical director of the Tone Management program. He is also an unaffiliated neurologic consultant to the NFL and an independent neurologic consultant to the Seattle Seahawks.

Dr. Browd received a dual degree (MD-PhD) in neuroplasticity from the University of Florida. His research interests include concussion, hydrocephalus, and biomedical engineering solutions in neurological surgery and sports safety. Dr. Browd has co-founded four venture-backed biomedical start-ups out of the University of Washington, where he serves as chief medical officer, including Proprio Surgical Inc. Dr. Browd serves as a University of Washington presidential entrepreneurial faculty fellow, and is on the advisory board of CoMotion, the university's commercialization arm. He lectures internationally on biomedical innovation and commercialization. Dr. Browd was recognized as the University of Washington School of Medicine inventor of the year in 2016.



### **David Mulder, MD, FRCS, FACS**

Dr. Mulder is professor and chairman in the department of Surgery at McGill University, following an appointment as surgeon-in-chief at the university's Montreal General Hospital. He is also the medical director of the McGill Sports Medicine Clinic and consulting staff for the Montreal Canadiens Hockey Club and Alouette Football Club. Dr. Mulder was the first recipient of the H. Rocke

Robertson Chair in Surgery at McGill University, and has contributed to medical science by publishing more than 230 scientific papers and chapters.

Dr. Mulder received his medical degree magna cum laude from the University of Saskatchewan College of Medicine. Following a year of rotating internship there, he received residency training in General Surgery at Montreal General Hospital. After a year in the department of Physiology as a research associate at McGill University, he was appointed to the faculty in 1970. He completed two years of residency in cardiovascular and thoracic surgery at the University of Iowa.

Dr. Mulder is a member of many professional societies, and held leadership roles in a number of them, including presidency of the American Association for the Surgery of Trauma in 1984, the Canadian Association of Clinical Surgeons in 1990, International Association for the Surgery of Trauma and Surgical Intensive Care in 1993, the Canadian Society of Cardiovascular and Thoracic Surgeons in 1995, and the Canadian Association of Surgical Chairmen, also in 1995. He is in high demand both as a speaker for prestigious lectureships and as a visiting professor, and has traveled

worldwide as a consultant for the delivery of trauma care. He also serves on the council and governorship of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada as well as the American College of Surgeons, and is sought after frequently as a surveyor and advisor by many medical institutions and government agencies.

One of the significant contributions made by Dr. Mulder in healthcare delivery was the important role he played in the development of a trauma care system in Quebec as a member of the Trauma Committee of the Province of Quebec. This system was based on regionalization of care, integrating four Level I trauma centers with more than 90 other trauma centers in Quebec. Modernization of the trauma care service will save many lives in Quebec.

Most of all, he is a skilled and compassionate surgeon, a productive clinical scientist and superb administrator. He contributes to the science and art of surgery and healthcare delivery in Canada and beyond, and is a highly respected member of society.



### **Kechi Okwuchi**

Ms. Okwuchi is a 29-year-old Nigerian-born woman, currently living in Houston. She is studying for her master's degree in business administration, and is a self-taught singer. Ms. Okwuchi found her voice after a 2005 plane crash in Nigeria that took the lives of all but two of the 109 passengers.

Throughout the difficult journey of burn recovery, Ms. Okwuchi was sustained by her faith, family and music. She resumed high school in 2009, and went on to college, where she graduated summa cum laude in 2015 with a bachelor's degree in economics. She began to sing and perform at her church, burn and trauma fundraisers, galas and family events, sharing what she loved with those she wanted to inspire.

On June 10, 2018, Ms. Okwuchi released her first single, "Don't You Dare," on all music platforms. She has since become a traveling artist, inspirational speaker and burn survivor advocate for multiple burn survivor organizations, including Shriners Burns Hospitals.

In 2019, Ms. Okwuchi became a finalist on America's Got Talent: The Champions through Simon Cowell's golden buzzer. She has now chosen to forge ahead on a path that allows her to explore both business and artistic opportunities.
